
#### **Summer Refresh: Dive into New Research Opportunities!**

You may have already noticed more projects using CloudResearch's latest survey-tool, Engage. Engage offers an exciting new opportunity for researchers and participants alike with its Al-powered interview capability. Unlike traditional surveys, when you participate in projects that use Engage, researchers will ask you to participate in interactions with an Al interviewer. These interviews allow you more freedom to express your opinions, while providing researchers with deeper insights. Not only are these tasks highly "engaging," but their complexity also means they often come with attractive pay rates! So keep an eye out for

projects using Engage and Al-interviews. Check out an example of what these interviews look like below:

## **Get Paid for Partially Completing a Task**

Select researchers now have the ability to provide participants with projects that include partial termination. What does this mean? For these projects (which are marked on Connect with a blue icon next to the study), you may be redirected back to Connect before completing the entire project. For example, if a researcher includes eligibility questions in their study that a participant doesn't meet, screened out participants will still receive partial payment for their time. We'll be rolling this



### **How to Qualify for More Projects**

As a reminder, be sure to follow these tips to ensure you see all projects you're qualified for:

Answer the "About You" questions. Questions in the "About You" section
are used by researchers to target projects toward participants. When there are
additional questions for you to complete, you'll see a notification with the
number of new questions next to the "About You" tab picture below.




Answering questions in the "About You" section allows you to qualify for more projects. You don't have to answer any question you're uncomfortable with, but answering more items will generally mean more projects.

Update the "About You" section. Life happens and details about you may
change. Maybe you switch jobs, take up a new hobby, get a raise at work, or
start dating someone new. When these or other changes happen, you may
want to update information in the "About You" section. If you need to update


your information, you can reach out to our <u>support team</u>. They can unlock qualifications and give you the chance to update your information.

• Turn on notifications. Within the Settings of your participant account, you have the option to turn on different notifications. In particular, you can opt to receive SMS text notifications when new projects launch that you are eligible for. These text notifications combined with the browser alerts we offer when you have Connect open are among the fastest ways to learn about studies in real-time.



**Note:** Notifications do not mean you will receive an alert for *every* project that becomes available to you. Our system prioritizes notifications to participants based on a set of rules and then gradually opens the study to participants who qualify but may not have been notified. This process gives people who are notified a fair chance of taking the project, but it also means some projects may appear on your dashboard even if you did not receive a notification.

Provide quality data. In order to help maintain quality on Connect, we have rolled out our participant grading system. You'll notice how you're doing in general on the Connect participant homepage with a score from 1 to 5 stars. If you click on this information, you'll get a more detailed view of your score which is based on 1) successful submissions 2) identity verification 3) Albased attention detection 4) rejected submissions and 5) negative feedback. Keep in mind a perfect score is not necessary but we recommend staying in the green.



High ratings are desirable because we prioritize people with high ratings within our study notifications (i.e., they will get first dibs and be notified more often). Keep in mind that doing better on projects and following Connect rules will allow you the opportunity to improve your score.

# **New Types of Tasks for AI Training**

You probably know that AI is a big deal, and companies are investing a lot of money to develop large language models like ChatGPT. But did you know that to build those models requires a lot of human data? Researchers often get data for AI applications from crowdsourcing sites like Connect.

Connect now offers new types of tasks for AI training now live and open to researchers. This means more researchers will be posting tasks to gather training data or conduct other small tasks to build projects directly on Connect. As a participant, you can take on more tasks, bringing you even more earning opportunities.

To make these tasks easier to complete, you can accept the project and then complete many tasks without having to submit each one and then accept a new project to complete another templating project. It also allows you to skip tasks within

a project. As the system is used by more researchers, we will continue to look for ways to improve the participant experience.
